General Information

1. Submission of an entry to this show constitutes agreement of the following: The exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless T.A.S.H.A. and O'Connor Ventures, Inc. d/b/a Great Southwest Equestrian Center ("GSEC"), its managers and their respective agents, contractors, officers, employees, directors, shareholders and assigns (together the "indemnities") harmless against any and all claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable legal fees, arising from the conduct of management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the GSEC or from any breach on the part of the Exhibitor, its agents, contractors, employees, guests or invitees in the GSEC. If any action or proceeding is brought against an indemnity by reason of any such claim the Exhibitor, upon notice from the Indemnity shall defend the action or proceeding by counsel acceptable to the indemnity. Under Texas Law (Chapter 87, Civil Practice and Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for any injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
2. **Deadline for entries is 8:00 P.M. Friday, December 2, 2011.** Post entries received after the deadline will be charged a post entry fee of \$5.00 per class. Post entries will be accepted up to one hour before the class. If you enter a class and do not ride in that class, you will not be charged if you have filled out a scratch form in the show office. If you wish to ride in a class after the one hour deadline, you may do so for a \$5.00 per class charge.
3. The exhibitor is responsible for the security of his own property, and neither GSEC nor T.A.S.H.A. is responsible for accidents, fire, or theft. All property of the Exhibitor left at GSEC is at the Exhibitor's risk. PLEASE GUARD PERSONAL EFFECTS.
4. Texas State Animal Health Commission Requirements must be met for all horses. A health certificate current within 45 days and a certificate showing a negative Coggins test within 12 months of the show date will be required for all horses.
5. Stall fees will be \$70.00 per stall. Stalls will be available for move in after 6 A.M., Friday, December 2, 2011. Anyone needing to move in before that time MUST make arrangements with show management. Move out is by 10:00 A.M., Monday, December 6. Bedding will be available on the grounds, and no outside shavings may be brought in (a minimum order of two bags per horse stall is mandatory). If you plan to arrive late, please notify show management to arrange for bedding to be left you. NO DOORS OR PANELS MAY BE REMOVED FROM STALLS.
6. EARLY/LATE FEE: Anyone arriving before 6 A.M. Friday, December 2 or leaving later than 10 A.M. on Monday, December 5 will be charged an additional \$35.00 per stall/per day.
7. All exhibitors must sign a release from liability before riding in a class. A parent or guardian must sign for those 18 years of age and under. Releases may be obtained in the show office.
8. All money must accompany the entry form and be paid before numbers can be issued. Any additional charges must be paid before leaving the show grounds.
9. Numbers must be worn and be clearly visible.

10. All dogs must be confined or kept on a leash. No dogs are allowed inside arena areas. Dog owners will be held solely responsible for the actions of their dogs.
11. Please dispose of manure in designated areas. Do not put manure in trash containers.
12. APPOINTMENTS FOR ALL-BREED CLASSES: Show Attire and Training Equipment is optional.
13. United State Equestrian Federation (USEF) rules will apply when appropriate. The decision of the judge is final.
14. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, and/or cancel entries; disqualify exhibitors; prohibit showing of entries; and award of prizes without claim for damages.
15. Show management reserves the right to cancel, divide, or combine any class or classes.
16. Class points will be awarded in their respective division for the T.A.S.H.A. High Point Awards. You must be a member of T.A.S.H.A. to be eligible.
17. Class points will also be awarded in their respective division for the Texas High Point Awards. The owner of the horse must be a member of T.A.S.H.A., N.T.A.S.H.A or S.A.S.H.A. to be eligible.
18. Class points will also be award in their respective Pleasure division for the ASHA High Point Awards. The owner of the horse must be a member of ASHA to be eligible.
19. This show is also a point qualifying show for the World Championship Horse Show in the Country Pleasure, Show Pleasure, and Park division.
20. Riders may not cross enter between ASB Classes and Academy classes.
21. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FROM EXHIBITORS AND/OR TRAINERS WHO HOLD OUTSTANDING DEBTS TO T.A.S.H.A.
22. Stall assignments will be based on the date and time of entry. Exhibitors must check the stall chart at the show office to insure they are in the correct stalls. Any Exhibitor moving into stalls assigned to someone else will be required to move into their assigned stalls without exception!

ATTENTION ALL ACADEMY RIDERS

UPHA CHAPTERS 6 & 7 ACADEMY GUIDELINES

**These new rules were agreed upon by all the trainers and instructors in
Chapter 6 & 7**

THE LESSON HORSE

1. Open only to horses or ponies used in a lesson program.
2. Horses may cross enter in performance classes at the same show.
3. Academy showmanship and performance classes should be judged on the riders' horsemanship and the overall picture of the rider and horse.
4. English tack is to be used, unless otherwise specified. Full, snaffle, or Pelham bridles may be used.
5. Academy equitation classes should be judged on BASIC equitation skills.

THE ACADEMY RIDER

1. Open to students enrolled in a lesson program.
2. An academy rider may cross enter in another division, but not at the same show, with the exceptions of driving classes.
3. Headers are allowed in all academy classes if needed for safety.
4. Once a rider has shown in a canter class of any breed, they may not return to the Walk/Trot division.
5. Acceptable attire includes dark slacks or jods, boots or footwear with heels, a collared shirt with vest or sweater, and a man's tie. Derbies or other traditional headgear is optional. No riding suits or day coats are allowed. Neatness of attire and cleanliness of tack will be judged.
6. Age of entries is determined by the age as of December 1 of the previous year (same as USEF rules).
7. Braiding and hoof blacking is optional.

The Beginner Walk/Trot and Adult divisions have not changed.

THE BEGINNER DIVISION—Classes are Walk/Trot Only.

These classes need to be consulted locally to determine the best age division to be used.

THE ADULT ACADEMY DIVISION—Classes are Walk/Trot/Canter

The Walk/Trot/Canter—Rider 17 and Under division has changed as follows:

THE ACADEMY MAIDEN DIVISION—Classes are Walk/Trot/Canter

For riders who have never won a blue ribbon in a Walk/Trot/Canter class.

THE ACADEMY LIMIT DIVISION—Classes are Walk/Trot/Canter

For riders who have won less than six blue ribbons in Walk/Trot/Canter classes.

Maiden riders qualify for this division also.

THE ACADEMY ADVANCED DIVISION—Classes are Walk/Trot/Canter

For riders who have won six or more blue ribbons AND have competed in the Academy Walk/Trot/Canter division for at least two years.

All blue ribbons won in the last two years in the Walk/Trot/Canter division—any age division—count toward which division you will show in.

Blue ribbons won in a one horse class do not count.

Any rider wishing to move up to the Advance division may do so, but may not return to the Limit Division.
